Subject: Majority of Battleground Voters Think Trump Should Testify Under Oath Before January 6th Committee, Support January 6th Investigation

Date: October 31, 2022

A new Public Policy Polling survey finds that, by a 36-point margin (62-26), voters in battleground states think that Donald Trump should testify under oath before the Congressional committee investigating what happened on January 6th at the U.S. Capitol. The poll was conducted in the following states: Arizona, Georgia, Michigan, Minnesota, North Carolina, Nevada, Pennsylvania, and Wisconsin.

Regarding concerns about the events of January 6th and the effort to overturn elections, half (50%) of voters think the problem was not only with Donald Trump, but also with members of the Republican Party who are loyalists to Trump. Just 12% of voters consider Trump to be the only problem.

In addition, voters support the Congressional investigation by a 20-point margin (56-36) and 61% of voters say the January 6th investigation is important to protecting democracy.

Majorities are concerned about the ongoing threats to Democracy and four specific Republican tactics stand out most to voters as major threats to democracy.

- 82% say that politicians changing the rules of voting to benefit their party is a major threat, including 87% of Democrats, 78% of independents, and 78% of Republicans. Only 6% say it isn't much of a threat.
- 69% say politicians who knowingly lie and spread conspiracies to undermine election results are a major threat, including 85% of Democrats, 62% of independents, and 57% of Republicans. Just 13% say it isn't much of a threat.
- 61% say voter suppression and intimidation is a major threat, including 78% of Democrats, 52% of independents, and a plurality (47%) of Republicans. Only 25% say it isn't much of a threat.
- 54% say politicians refusing to accept the results of elections they lose is a major threat, including 76% of Democrats and 47% of independents. Just 21% say this isn't much of a threat.

When examining the facts uncovered by the investigation, a majority of battleground voters (60%) say they are concerned about Donald Trump and his allies who have been trying to send falsified electors, alter state laws, and even throw out state vote counts in order to overturn the election results. This includes a majority of independents (55%), while just 35% overall express no concern.

Voters also express major concerns over other issues uncovered by the January 6th investigation:



- 68% are concerned (with 54% saying they have very serious concerns) about Trump demanding that Mike Pence overturn the election result for him even after White House lawyers told him it was illegal. This includes a majority (59%) of independents.
- 65% are concerned (with 49% very concerned) about Trump and his allies telling people there was voter fraud in the 2020 election, even after some of Trump's lawyers and the Attorney General told them there was no widespread fraud. Even a majority (57%) of independents are concerned.
- 62% are concerned (with 54% very concerned) about Trump knowing that many of his supporters attending his rally on January 6th were armed yet instructing them to march on the Capitol anyway. Even 54% of independents are concerned.
- 61% are concerned (with 51% very concerned) about Trump signing legal documents claiming evidence of election fraud that he knew was false, including a majority of independents (55%).

Public Policy Polling surveyed 830 voters from the battleground states Arizona, Georgia, Michigan, Minnesota, North Carolina, Nevada, Pennsylvania, and Wisconsin from October 26-27, 2022. The margin of error is +/- 3.4%. 57% of interviews for the survey were conducted by text message and 43% by telephone.
